American Rescue Plan Overview \$3,220,636

- Spending plan must be approved by April 30th
- New Expanded Guidance released on Jan. 6
- Much more flexibility
 - ► Lost Revenue clause
 - ▶ Up to \$10M
 - General Govt. Services
 - Must spend the money

Ineligible Uses of Funding

Not free money

Debt service or legal settlements or judgements

Pension fund deposits

Rainy day fund or financial reserve deposits

Infrastructure Projects: \$1.54M

- Water System Generators: \$140K
- Urban Water Management Plan: \$75K
- ► Fire Flow Study: \$60K
- Water Main Line Replacement: \$350K
- ▶ Filter Bank Renovation: \$250K
- ▶ DBP Mitigation Project: \$350K
- ► Turbidimeter Replacement: \$45K
- Water Plant Upgrades: \$29K
- WWTP Clarifier Gate Valves: \$43K
- ► Harvard Park: \$100K
- ▶ WWTP Clarifier Repairs: \$100K


How do we Maximize the funds?
